## Who are we up against?

*Paul Craig Roberts, was Assistant Treasury Secretary in Ronald Reagan's cabinet, and author of eight books. He's written for such publications as the New York Times and the Wall Street Journal. He defines the power elites:*

"The U.S. now resembles an oligarchy of private interests. The most powerful ones are Wall Street, AIPAC (the American Israel Public Affairs Committee), the military-security complex, the oil industry, agri-business, insurance and pharmaceuticals. These private interests control economic and foreign policy, write the legislation that Congress passes and the President signs, and have achieved the monopolization of the U.S. economy by large-scale commercial organizations. As far as I can tell, traditional conservatives scarcely exist in the U.S. today. They have been eliminated by the neo-conservatives, essentially militarists committed to U.S. world hegemony."

## What is the Constitution Party all about?

The Constitution Party upholds the principles of the U.S. Constitution—according to the original intent of the Founding Fathers. We are inspired by Howard Phillips, the founder of our party, who said: *"We stand for what George Washington stood for—limiting the federal government to its delegated, enumerated functions, and restoring American jurisprudence to its biblical common law foundations."*
